D.M : History of IKARI, first steps, from the beginning to the top...
JUST ICE : IKARI was found by PAL+Ultima in July 87. Nik joined one week later. I joined in October 87 and two months later PAL sold his computer and Ultima joined ORION. At Easter 88 Tridos joined, also MAKK+Art but they left after a week to make a game and the 4 members of Jewels joined IKARI in June '88.

D.M : According to you, what is IKARI's place in the piracy world ? Why ?
JUST ICE : One of the fastest crackers in the world. Why ? Because we get originals very fast.

D.M : Well, nearly all the games are english and so you get and crack them before every continental group. Then, how do proceed the big european groups to swap with you ? Are you charitable ? Or are they faster than you ?
JUST ICE : Some games are released faster on the continent. And some groups have english members who crack for them so they're equal to us. With the others we trade out of friendship and to get greetings, but also to get all the demos released.

D.M : Wich/Who are the groups/guys you do like the most ? Those you hate ? Why ?
 Do ya have some enemies at the moment ?
JUST ICE : I like : Hotline, Triad, CFR, 2000 AD
 Hate : we don't hate anybody but we seem not to get along with the Beastie Boys. Why ? --> They called us freezers and never apologised.

D.M : How can you explain the fact there is only a few groups in England whereas all the games are released there ?
JUST ICE : Two reasons - Not everybody has the money to buy 5-10 originals a week and to send them to 20-30 people. Maybe there's not enough talent, all the good coders write games or go on compunet.

D.M : Do you think the 64 has a future ?
JUST ICE : Yes, but a limited one. I see the Amiga take over in about 18 months. But at this moment there are still a lot of games released and as long as there are games released there will be crackers.

D.M : Opinion 'bout the pirating world ?
JUST ICE : It's very interesting, it has changed a lot from what it used to be due to the americans who have given it a big boost but have destroyed it in some ways too.

D.M : Your projects for the future ?
JUST ICE : We hope to XXXX (sorry dear readers I really can't read Mad All's ugly handwriting, but I'm sure you'll understand what **JUST ICE** said. **JAYCE**) our quality and good name on the AMIGA as it is on the 64 now.

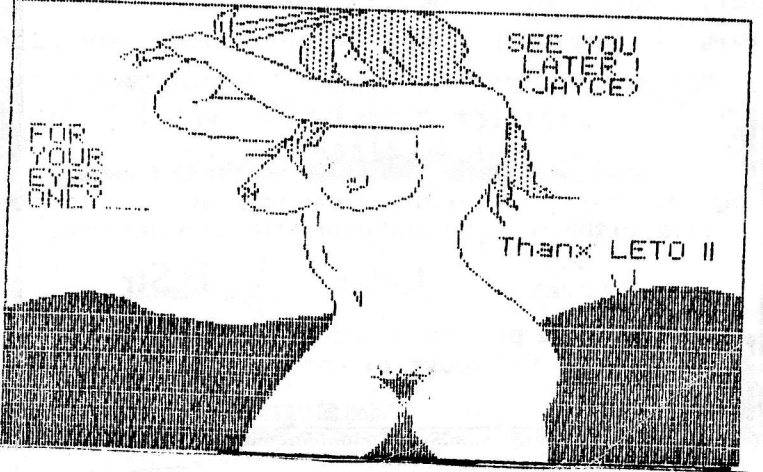

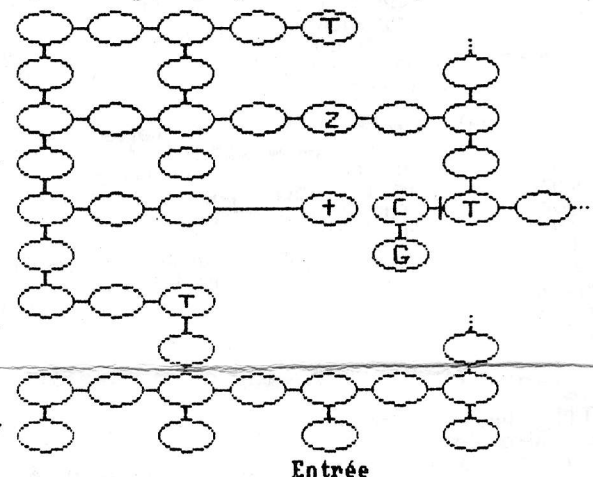

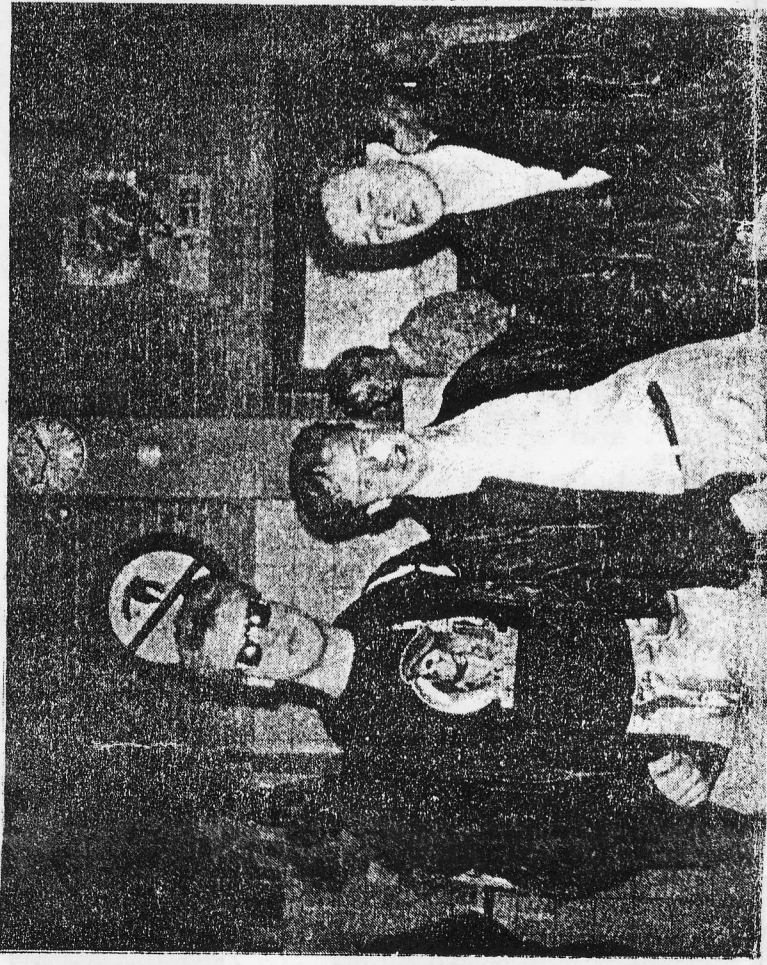
